SHS-Fremont Ross Games to Continue

Sandusky still plans to maintain its historic rivalry with Fremont Ross, SHS Director of Athletics, Susan Sackett said Tuesday after the Little Giants were accepted to the Toledo City League. "We'll always have them on the schedule," And that holds true for all sports, not just football.

This year's gridiron contest, which took place Oct. 30 at Strobel Field, was selected as part of the Great American Rivalry series. Only four other games in Ohio and 32 teams across the country were chosen for this distinction by iHigh Marketing.

Once Sandusky moves into the Northern Ohio League for the 2011-12 season, the game will move from the last game of the season to the first.

"We already have them scheduled for 2011-2012 on Week 1," Sackett said. "It worked for both schools when we were trying to look ahead.

"you can build up hype at the beginning (of the season) or you can build it up in the end."

iHigh Marketing will award \$500.00 scholarships to a Sandusky and Ross senior football player with the highest GPA,

and will induct a former player from each team into its Hall of Fame.

The winner of the game received a Great American Rivalry Series trophy.

Sandusky was interested in remaining in the same league with Ross, and school officials publicly stated at board meetings their hopes of bringing the Little Giants with them to the NOL.

Both teams have been part of the Greater Buckeye Conference since 2003, though the league is rapidly losing members. While the Toledo City League will welcome Fremont Ross, it denied admission to two other GBC schools - Findlay and Lima Senior.

Sackett said she was open to the idea of keeping some teams in the GBC, depending on the sport.

There is a possibility Sandusky could face Ross and Perkins in the first two weeks of the football season, though the Sandusky-Perkins game was initially a two-year contract.

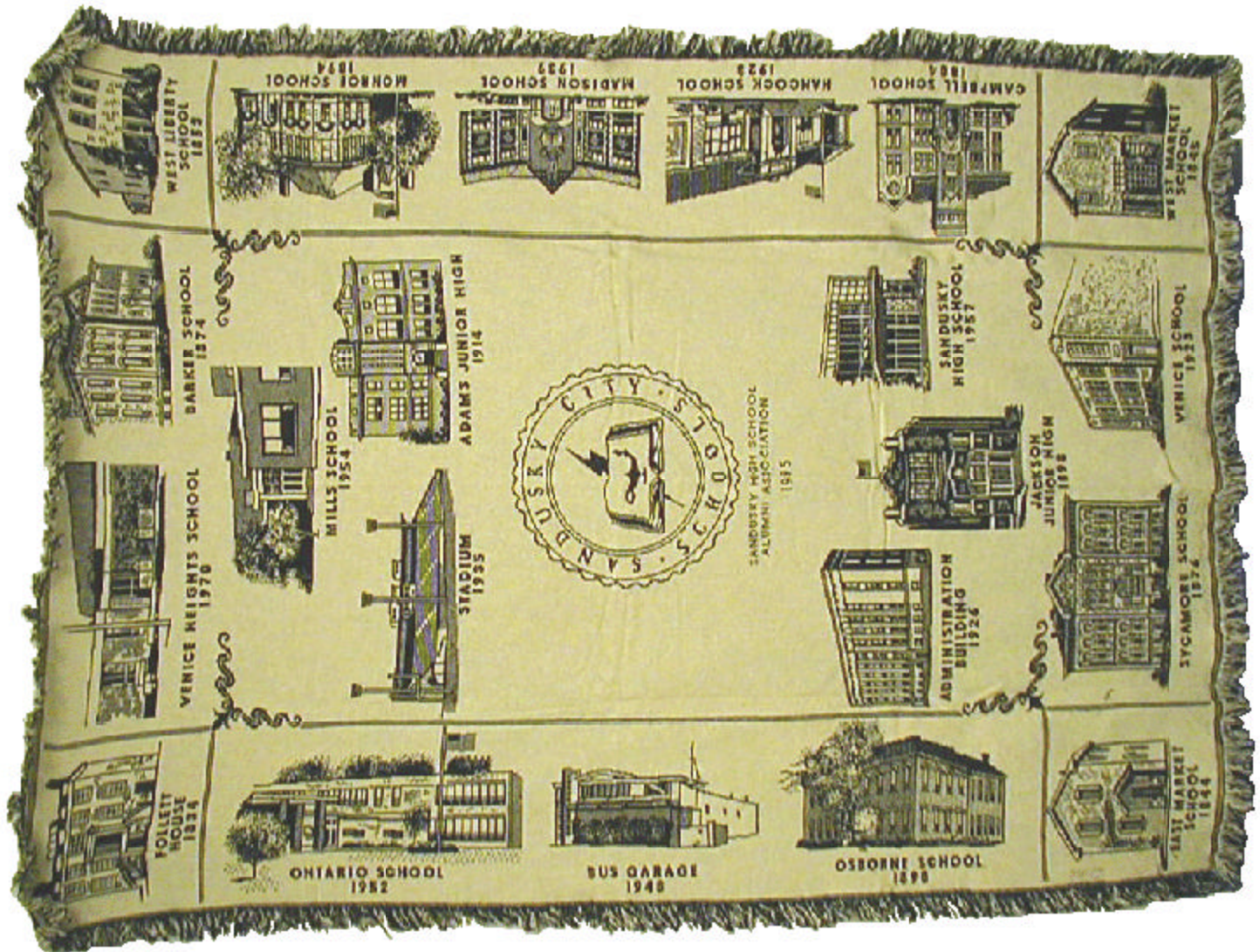

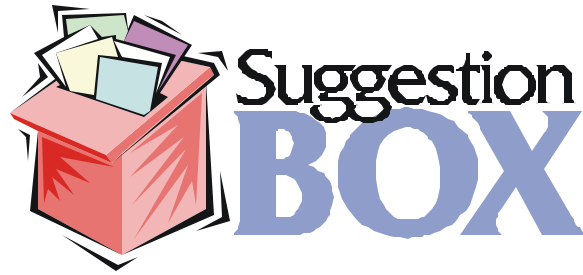
